

Flower Fundraising Coordinator

Provide oversight and coordination to our annual flower fundraiser. Duties include working with the supplier, scheduling start and end dates for sale, organizing delivery and pick up of product, balance all receipts and provide breakout of profits to treasurer for processing.

Class B/T-Shirt Sales

This leader will work with the vendor to price product for our annual order. Distribute order forms, collect orders and money, place order with vendor. Distribute order upon receipt. Provide deposit details to treasurer for processing.

Outings Co-Coordinator

Share this very important position with Henrietta Bellucci. Jill McCue has been doing this role for a number of years and it is time for her to “pass the torch”. Learn the ropes from Jill and share the workload with Henrietta.

Equipment Co-Coordinator

Work with Frank Simmons to learn the ins and outs of maintaining and caring for the Troop equipment. Provide guidance to the Scout held Quartermaster position.

Adult Training & Recognition

Identify training needs for our adult leaders and provide details regarding training opportunities (you don't conduct the training). Submit recognition for leaders as appropriate.

Shopping/Grocery Coordinator(s)

Do you like a good bargain? Are you an expert at feeding a large number on a small budget? Well this is the job for you! We need someone who will work with the Scouts to do shopping for their food prior to campouts. This can be a multi-person role.

Public Relations Coordinator

Troop 66 does a whole bunch of really awesome things, but we rarely see them in the news. This person will take on the challenge of submitting articles to the local papers and the Council newsletter, advertising open house events and getting the Troop recognized in our community.

Transportation Coordinator(s)

This is a multi-person role. We need to know if you have a vehicle that is able to pull our trailers. The trailer typically needs pulled to our monthly campouts and to summer camp. Details regarding the hitch and braking requirements can be discussed with Dick Gobrecht.

Board of Review Coordinator

Become a member of the advancement committee, working for Randy Anderson our Advancement Chairman. This person will aid in organizing enough members to conduct our monthly board of reviews. Individual may assist with other advancement duties as needed.

Board of Review Members

Learn what it takes to conduct a Board of Review. We are always looking to train parents to help with this very important role. We need 3 adults for each Scout board of review. Some nights we have needed up to 12 BOR members are one time!

Friends of Scouting Coordinator

Arrange for the annual Friends of Scouting presentation. You are not expected to do the presentation but are asked to coordinate the event. You will also collect the pledge cards from our Troop families to turn into the District representative.

Additional Fundraising Coordinator(s)

We love our flower fundraiser! But hey, let's face it there are a number of additional fundraising opportunities out there. Let's offer a few additional opportunities for the scouts to earn money for their scout accounts. Your ideas are needed! This can be a multi-person role.

Facebook Fan Pagemaster

Are you a Facebook user? Well so are most of our scouts and parents. Can you set up a fan page and monitor the posts? This would be a perfect job for someone who is already a daily Facebook person.

Copy Sponsors
