**Location:** Glenwood Park, Batavia, IL  
**Departure:** Scouts need to arrive at Glenwood Park by 7:00pm on Fri., July 9. Parents need to drop off their scout(s) to the camp site with standard camping equipment, bicycle and helmet (mandatory). You must check in your scout(s) with an adult leader.

**Return:** Parents need to pick up their scout(s) and all equipment (including bicycle, etc.) from the camp site by 11:30 a.m. on Sunday, July 11, 2010. NO ONE WILL BE ALLOWED TO LEAVE THE CAMP SITE UNTIL IT IS PACKED UP! Scouts must check out with an adult leader before they leave.

**Cost:** Scouts: \$18.00 (includes food and camp fee)

**Bring:** Bicycle, helmet, personal first aid kit, scout book, camping gear & clothing appropriate for the weather.

**Uniform:** Class A for Travel & Class B for activities

**Activity:** There will be a 10 – 35 mile bike ride on this campout. No scouts are allowed to stay in the campsite. If you camp, you must be prepared to bike.
